

Low Cost Spay/Neuter Certificate

Redemption Procedure

~ Please note - Your Certificate Has an Expiration Date ~
The surgery must be done before the expiration date.

Salem Friends of Felines (SFOF) will only help pay for the spay/neuter surgery itself.

All other costs required at the time of the surgery are your responsibility to pay to the clinic.

You must call the veterinary clinic to make an appointment as they do not perform these services on a walk-in basis.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR APPOINTMENT & IMPORTANT INFO

Contact one of the listed Participating Veterinary Clinics (*see page #2*) to schedule the surgery.

Tell the clinic you have a Low Cost Spay/Neuter Certificate from Salem Friends of Felines when you make the appointment.

Follow the direction the clinic gives you regarding food and water the night before the surgery. If they do not tell you that information, please call them to find out.

Make sure your kitty is in a secure cat carrier marked with your name, phone number and the name of the kitty.

Take the certificate with the kitty to the clinic on the morning of the surgery. The clinic will charge you the copay written on your voucher before they will admit your kitty into the clinic.

It is very important that you keep your scheduled surgery appointment, as the clinic has set aside a special surgery time for your kitty.

If you cannot keep your appointment, please call the clinic right away to reschedule before your certificate expires.

SFOF will not be held responsible for any of the costs caused by:



Taking your kitty to a veterinary clinic that is not a listed *Participating Veterinary Clinic*

The clinic is not accepting certificates at the time you schedule the surgery (some clinics may limit the number of certificates they accept each month)

You will be responsible for all costs of the surgery and visit, we cannot pay clinics that are not on our contracted list of clinics or have a limit to how many vouchers they accept.

****** Costs such as, but not limited to: vaccines, flea treatment, exams, blood work, IV fluids, pain medications and costs associated with the kitty being in heat or pregnant or other surgical complications are not covered by the spay/neuter voucher and will be the full responsibility of the person/owner presenting the voucher at the time of service.
