

SFOF Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Voucher Redemption Procedures

Please note that your voucher has an expiration date, and the surgery must be done before the expiration date to use the voucher.

Salem Friends of Felines (SFOF) will only pay for the spay/neuter surgery. Any additional fees incurred at the time of the surgery are the responsibility of the voucher holder to pay to the clinic.

Voucher holders must call the participating veterinary clinic to make an appointment as clinics do not perform surgery on a walk-in basis.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR APPOINTMENT & IMPORTANT INFO

- Contact one of the participating veterinary clinics to schedule the surgery and let the clinic know you have a low-cost spay/neuter voucher from Salem Friends of Felines when you make the appointment.
- 2. Follow any directions from the clinic regarding fasting the night before the surgery. Most clinics require that the patient have no food given after 9:00 PM the night before the surgery and no food the morning of the surgery. Water should not be restricted.
- 3. Secure your kitty in a safe cat carrier labeled with your name, phone number and the name of the kitty.
- 4. Bring the voucher with you on the morning of the surgery. The clinic will collect your co-pay before they admit your kitty into the clinic for surgery.
- 5. It is very important that you keep your scheduled surgery appointment as the clinic has set aside time for your kitty. If you cannot keep your appointment, please call the clinic 24 hours prior to the appointment and be sure to reschedule the surgery before your voucher expires.
- 6. SFOF WILL NOT be responsible for any costs incurred due to the following:
 - 1. Use of a veterinary clinic that does not participate in the SFOF low-cost spay/neuter voucher program.
 - 2. Use of a veterinary clinic that is not accepting SFOF low-cost spay/neuter vouchers at the time of surgery (some participating clinics do limit the number of vouchers they accept each month).
 - 3. Additional or optional services at the time of surgery including but not limited to: vaccines, flea treatment, deworming, health exams, bloodwork, IV fluids, additional pain medications and costs associated with the kitty being in heat or pregnant and any surgical complications are not covered by the SFOF low-cost spay/neuter voucher program and will be the full responsibility of the person/owner presenting the voucher at the time of service.
